

(1-A) International Creator Residency Program 2023 (Individual Projects)

Application Outline

Tokyo Arts and Space (TOKAS), operated by a division of The Museum of Contemporary Art Tokyo, offers artist-in-residence programs for international creators working in various creative fields to stay, engage in creation, and conduct research activities in Tokyo. It also provides creators with the opportunities to exchange creative ideas and to present outcomes of their residency at TOKAS-organized events, such as the Open Studio.

The open-call program “International Creator Residency Program” aims to invite distinguished and highly motivated creators in the field of visual art, film, design, and architecture from all over the world and offer them with opportunities to work in Tokyo. We provide financial support to allow creators to develop and present new works and ideas. The result of the residency will be presented at the Open Studio and/or the Result Presentation.

1. Target for this program

This program is aimed at those creators

- who are willing to explore new creative activities.
- who practice in any of the following cultural/ artistic fields:
visual art, film, design, and architecture.

3. What TOKAS offers

Living space (single room), shared studio, airfare, living expenses (per diem), and fee for creative work/project

- Airfare: A round-trip economy-class air ticket between the nearest airport from the place of residence and Tokyo (either Narita or Haneda Airport) will be provided.
- Living expenses (per diem): JPY 3,500 (consumption tax excluded) per day
- Fee for work/project: JPY 300,000 (consumption tax excluded)

*Income tax will be deducted from the above amounts.

*The single room will be provided for the stay by the participating creator only. A twin-bedded room will be provided to creators applying as a duo.

4. Eligibility

- ① Resides outside of Japan.
- ② Has 5 years or more of experience in his/her specialized area of expertise.
- ③ Has sufficient ability to communicate in English with other residing creators and TOKAS staff for mutual understanding.
- ④ Independent and capable of working and living on his/her own.
- ⑤ Creators working as a duo are also eligible. (A duo consisting of at least one creator residing outside of Japan is eligible.)
- ⑥ Students are ineligible (except for Ph.D. candidates).

5. Requirements/Conditions

- ① Able to stay consecutively at TOKAS Residency during the proposed residency period.
- ② Shall create the work to be presented at Open Studio and submit a comprehensive report on the proposed project.
- ③ Participate in the Result Presentation and other programs if asked by TOKAS, and cooperates with its public relations activity.
- ④ Do not carry out any commercial or profitable activities throughout the residency period.
- ⑤ Do not conduct any activities that would make big noise or vibration in TOKAS Residency.
- ⑥ The Accommodation is provided for the participating creator only. Family members, partners, friends or guests are not permitted to stay at TOKAS Residency.

6. Application Deadline

Deadline to submit documents: July 26, 2022, 18:00 (JST)

Deadline to submit support materials: August 2, 2022, 23:00 (JST)

7. Selection Schedule

Selection stage: review with external juries in the end of August, 2022

*The successful applicants will be informed of their final results individually by the end of September, 2022.

The final results will be announced through our website at the beginning of October, 2022.

*We do not respond to any individual inquiries on the selection process and result.

9. Application

- ① Application Form 1 and Application Form 2 (.pdf file): has to be filled in English
- ② Two letters of recommendation (.pdf file): have to be prepared by two different referees (stated in “2) Referee in Application Form 2”) from art and cultural institutions, related educational organizations, or professionals specialized in the fields of art and culture.
*Letters must include signatures of the referees, written in either English or Japanese in A4 format.
*Please send the scanned PDF files of letters by July 26, 2022.
- ③ Support materials: referring to Manual (.pdf file), send support materials stated in “12) Past Projects in Application Form 2”.

*Any application which does not meet the requirements stated in this outline will not be accepted.

*Application is non-returnable.

10. TOKAS Residency Facilities

-Single room (25 m²) / twin-bedded room (49 m²)

*Each accommodation is equipped with kitchen, toilet, bath, furniture (bed, desk, chairs, etc.), refrigerator, air-conditioner, tableware, towels, and sets of linen.
