

Research Residency Program 2024 Application Outline

Tokyo Arts and Space (TOKAS), operated by a division of The Museum of Contemporary Art Tokyo, offers artist-in-residence programs for international creators working in various creative fields to stay, engage in creation, and conduct research activities in Tokyo. It also provides creators with the opportunities to exchange creative ideas and to present outcomes of their residency at TOKAS-organized events, such as the Open Studio.

The open-call program “Research Residency Program” aims to invite distinguished and highly motivated creators in the field of visual art, film, design, architecture, music, sound art, performing art and curation from all over the world and offer them with opportunities to work in Tokyo.

1. Target for this program

This program is aimed at those creators

-who are willing to conduct research activities with their own theme(s) in Tokyo.

-who practice in any of the following cultural/ artistic fields:

visual art, film, design, architecture, music, sound art, performing art and curation.

2. Residency Period / Number of Creators

[Residency Period]

6 to 12 weeks within the following residency periods:

① From the beginning of May, 2024 to the end of July, 2024

② From the beginning of January, 2025 to the end of March, 2025

[Number of Creators (tentative)]

4 creators in total (2 creators per period)

3. What TOKAS offers

Living space (single room)

* A twin-bedded room will be provided to creators applying as a duo.

*In principle, this program does not provide working studio for the participating creators.

4. Eligibility

- ① Has considerable experience in his/her specialized area of expertise and is expected to make good achievements in the near future.
- ② Has sufficient ability to communicate in English with other residing creators and TOKAS staff for mutual understanding.
- ③ Independent and capable of working and living on his/her own.
- ④ Creators working as a duo are also eligible.
- ⑤ Students are ineligible (except for Ph.D. candidates.)

5. Requirements / Conditions

- ① Able to stay consecutively at TOKAS Residency during the proposed residency period.
- ② Conduct research activities relevant to Tokyo to contribute to the development of its art and culture scenes and submit a comprehensive report on the proposed project.
- ③ Participate in Open Studio and other programs if asked by TOKAS, and cooperates with its public relations activity.
- ④ Do not carry out any commercial or profitable activities throughout the residency period.
- ⑤ Do not conduct any activities that would make big noise or vibration in TOKAS Residency.
- ⑥ The accommodation is provided for the participating creator only. Family members, partners, friends or guests are not permitted to stay at TOKAS Residency.

6. Application Deadline

Deadline to submit documents: **June 26, 2023, 18:00 (JST)**

Deadline to submit support materials: **July 3, 2023, 23:00 (JST)**

7. Selection Schedule

Selection stage: review with external juries in August, 2023

*The successful applicants will be informed of their final results individually by the end of September, 2023.

The final results will be announced through our website at the beginning of October, 2023.

*We do not respond to any individual inquiries on the selection process and result.

8. Application Method

9. Application

- ① Application Form 1 and 2 (.pdf file): have to be filled in either English or Japanese.
- ② Two letters of recommendation (.pdf file): have to be prepared by two different referees (stated in “**3) Referees**” in **Application Form 2**) from art and cultural institutions, related educational organizations, or professionals specialized in the fields of art and culture.
*Letters must include signatures of the referees, written in either English or Japanese in A4 format.
*Please send the scanned PDF files of letters by June 26, 2023, 18:00 (JST).
- ③ Support materials: referring to Manual (.pdf file), send support materials stated in “**14) Past Projects**” in **Application Form 2**.

*Any application which does not meet the requirements stated in this outline will not be accepted.

10. TOKAS Residency Facilities

- Location: TOKAS Residency (2-14-7 Tatekawa, Sumida-ku, Tokyo)
- Single room (25 m²) / twin-bedded room (49 m²)
*Each accommodation is equipped with kitchen, toilet, bath, furniture (bed, desk, chairs, etc.), refrigerator, air-conditioner, tableware, towels, and sets of linen.
- Wi-Fi internet connection: All day accessible
- Common spaces: Available from 9:30 - 22:00.
*Networking room (equipped with kitchen, dining and living room sets, computer, printer, TV, etc.), library, laundry, and shared studios (125 m² and 48 m²)
